

Douglas Rucker, Writer, Exec. Producer

Douglas Rucker is a playwright and director in the theatre world for over 35 years in both community and professional theatre. His plays have been commissioned by Morris Brown College, Uptown Cultural District Group, Arts Council of Fayetteville N.C., the Bottomline Playhouse, and the Kimmel Cancer Center. His plays and staged readings have been produced in NewYork, Philadelphia, Fayetteville, N.C., Atlanta, GA, and the Frank Silvera Writers Workshop in Harlem, New York.

He was co-founder of his first theatre company- African American Theatre Company in Fayetteville, N. C., and was one of the first local artists to have his work produced in the original Philadelphia Fringe Festival in 1999. Douglas has spent the last six years of his life serving his community as the Executive Director of the Chew and Chelten CDC, and Creator and Interim Artistic Director of the newly founded...the Hip Hop Symphony Ensemble.



John Graves III, Director

John W. Graves III, founder, and director of John Graves Productions (JGP) and Heres2CoolStuff Clothing Store (H2CS) is a Philadelphia native, entrepreneur, educator, student, producer, writer, and performing artist. He's received training from Evelyn Graves School of Performing Arts and Co., Freedom Theatre, Wilkes University, West Chester University, & Drexel University.

At the age of 19, Graves produced his first musical production. Following the success of the production, he founded John Graves Productions. Since 2007, Graves has continued to use the arts to educate, enrich, serve, and inspire the community and audiences abroad. He has received several awards, acknowledgements, and citations from the city of Philadelphia and state of Pennsylvania and a special citation from the Governor of PA for his contributions in the arts over the years.

Currently, Graves runs John Graves Productions and Heres2CoolStuff while performing as an artist. He also travels to teach, direct, and consult for entrepreneurs, small businesses, non-profits, theaters, arts and entertainment companies, churches, and schools.
